IFRS (International Financial Reporting Standards), initially introduced as the intra-European Union's standards and has been adopted or is currently expected to be introduced in more than 100 countries, has been making its global presence. In Japan, the Financial Services Agency published an interim report in June 2009 allowing the use of IFRS on a voluntary basis and attention is focused in future trends. The IASC (International Accounting Standards Committee), which is responsible for developing IFRS, has been advancing development of the taxonomy in order to use IFRS in XBRL as part of IFRS development aiming to codification of concepts, organizing the presentation of financial statements, improve access to financial reports and so on. Use of XBRL has been spreading worldwide: it was adopted by the Financial Services Agency of Japan in 2008 for financial reporting on the new EDINET, the Tokyo Stock Exchange began using it on TDnet in 2009, and the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) announced its mandatory use in 2008, and so on. The stage has now been reached where XBRL is expected to spread more widely as a common global language to facilitate the convergence, understanding and implementation of IFRS, in line with the progress of IFRS itself.

Considering such current background, XBRL Japan and the Japanese Institute of Certified Public Accountants have organized the symposium titled "XBRL and IFRS: Two Common Languages to Reform the World". This symposium will offer a varied program, including information of current status for considering to adopt IFRS, expectations toward XBRL in Japan and the latest trends in promoting XBRL in Europe, the United States and Asia; workshops on trends in computerizing corporate actions using XBRL, study session for IFRS taxonomy practitioners, vender session of XBRL-related products, and more.

We believe that the participants will be able to get a clear idea of the relationship between XBRL and IFRS and the potential uses that can be expected when XBRL becomes more common as IFRS is adopted, and what the future look like when they become essential communications tools in the financial and capital markets through interoperable between ISO20022, and so on.

We look forward to the participation in this symposium of the personnel working in the accounting, finance or disclosure divisions of listed companies, institutional investors, security

analysts and those of financial institutions, governmental institutions who use the financial information in XBRL, and those who are considering the use of various services in XBRL.

We sincerely hope that your participation in this symposium may help to deepen your understanding of the world of XBRL which is expected to continue its expansion.
